Challenges

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- Limited access to diabetes resources often results in nurses relying heavily on Diabetes Nurse Educators (DNEs).
- Stronger reliance on the DNEs prolongs discharge procedures, particularly on weekends and holidays.
- Patients may leave the hospital without the essential diabetes resources. This increases the challenges on self-management.

IMPLEMENTATIONS

Create a visual poster for easy access and utilisation of resources

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Nursing leaders will cascade the information via email, detailing the how and where to access digital resources.

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Encourage nursing leaders and staff to spread the word about the poster

OUTCOVHES

- Reducing nurse reliance on Diabetes Nurse Educators (DNEs) leads to increased nurse efficiency and job satisfaction
- Faster discharge times are achieved, even on weekends and holidays
- Patients receive necessary tools for self-management, leading to improved patient outcomes
- Promotes continuity of care and cost savings
